## **Senior & Family Portraits | \$299/45 min Session**

Stunning portraits created by combining the beauty of the outdoors with the lighting of the studio through on location studio flash. Sessions includes quick editing touch-ups. More extensive editing is available for \$15/photo. Unlike other photographers, there is no charge for shooting at multiple locations. Customers are simply charged based on the time from the start to the end of the session. Online album and mailed DVD for printing are included. Customer receives rights to unlimited prints.

## **Special Events | \$450/hr 90 min**

Let us capture your memories at special events such as graduations, sports events, , etc. Package includes quick editing touch-ups. More extensive editing is available for \$15/photo. Online album and mailed DVD for printing are included. Customer receives rights to unlimited prints.

## **Weddings | \$2,299 for 8 Hours & 1 Hour Engagement Session. \$100 For Each Additional Hour**

Treasure and relive your memories through our stunning photos. I believe your photos will be the best when you are comfortable and relaxed. I work hard to provide professional service while maintaining a relaxed atmosphere. Package includes between 600-1,00 high quality images with color adjustments available by online album and mailed dvd. Customer receives rights to unlimited prints. ## **Fine Print**

Reservations are not confirmed until contact\* is notified via email by Anderson Photography (A.P.) confirming reservation. A down-payment of 50% is required for the reservation of special events and wedding photography. Photos are released only after A.P. has been paid in full. Upon release of photos, customer is given full rights to edit and reprint photos. A.P. reserves the right to use images for marketing such as Facebook Sneak Peaks, Website examples, etc. A.P. will maintain a copy of files for 30 days after images are delivered by either DVD or upload. After 30 days, A.P. is not responsible for the storing of files from the events or sessions.

**Cancelation of Events** For weddings: \$150 for engagement session. 60 day notice, 25% fee. 30 day notice, 50% fee. 15 day notice, no refund. All other appointments: 30 day notice, 25% fee. 15 day notice, 50% fee. 5 day notice, 75% fee or a 10% rescheduling fee will be applied if rescheduling is desired. While Anderson Photography works to make the best of all situations, A.P. will not be held responsible for any "Acts of God" or other events which are outside the control of A.P. such as failure of both primary and backup SD memory cards, severe weather, traffic accidents, sudden life threatening illness, etc. Clients agree not to sue A.P. for more than the cost of an event, understanding that A.P. goes to great lengths to protect your investment. Any concerns, questions, or objections to these terms must be brought to the attention of A.P. in writing prior to down-payment for event. By making the required down-payment or confirmation for scheduling, you are the contact for the event and responsible for the final payment. Photos may only be released to the contact for event or to others by their express permission.

# Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Preferred style of photography:** I love taking advantage of natural light when outside but often use flash units both inside and outdoors to balance lighting. During dance photos I use color filters to add highlight colors behind the bride and groom, making the photos pop with an artistic flare.
- 2. Weddings I have shot:** I have been shooting weddings since 2011. Customers are consistently thrilled with my work and find me easy to work with. I have also worked for another photographer, which means that I'm trusted by other professionals with their clients.
- 3. Back to back weddings:** I typically only shoot one wedding in a weekend. I never two weddings on a single day.
- 4. On site studio lighting :** I always take off camera lighting with me. I try to limit the use of strobes however I don't hesitate to use it for corrective and artistic lighting.
- 5. Do you work from a shot list:** Yes, I keep a digital and a hardcopy of the shot list from the bride and groom.
- 6. Can I request certain images:** Yes, I enjoy keeping the bridal party engaged in creating photos but I do request that photo ideas be suggested before the wedding if possible. It is important to understand that particular poses like some on Pinterest require setup and thus must be limited in quantity.
- 7. When do you begin shooting:** I find photos at the hair dresser to be special moments for the bride. Also, the extra time in the morning really helps to relax the bridal party before the ceremony. I always show up a little early to make sure everything gets off to a smooth start.
- 8. Do you bring a second shooter:** I typically do not bring a second photographer. The reason is that in general, the additional investment will not return substantially better photos while also adding to the number of people moving around during a ceremony.
- 9. How many images can I expect to get:** I typically deliver around 800- 1,000 quality photos for a wedding.
- 10. How long until I see my photos:** I typically have your wedding photos edited within one week. Depending on how the photos are being delivered, you can expect your photos for ordering prints within three weeks of your wedding.
- 11. Advertising:** Photos may be used for advertising on Facebook, Pinterest, A.P. website, etc. Content sensitive photos are never used for advertising. I will ask to use photos for album sneak peaks on Facebook.
- 12. Request for photography guidelines at venue:** I will speak with the pastor or officiant of the wedding before the start of the ceremony to make sure expectations are understood.
- 13. What will you wear:** Black dress pants and dress shirt with a tie and vest.
- 14. Plan in case of emergency:** I know a few other photographers I can contact. I would never miss a scheduled event unless I was physically injured or my immediate family was dying.
- 15. Equipment:** Full frame Nikon 750 & backup. 70-200mm 2.8f, 50mm 1.8f, 24-70mm 2.8f, wide angle lens if needed. Tripod. Wireless flash lighting. Filters and umbrellas for light diffusion.
- 16. Who will shoot your wedding:** I will be shooting your wedding. I never send another photographer to shoot unless a death of a family member or sever illness causes a scheduling conflict I can not avoid.
- 17) How do prints work:** You will receive rights to unlimited prints and sharing of your photos. Color and lighting editing is included. More involved editing can be requested for an additional amount of \$50 per 30 minutes. I do not process prints. I suggest a couple of professional options in an informational packet you will receive, but I believe customers are best served when they order their own prints.
